

### Additional Services Fees Sheet

This document outlines what is included in the Additional Services Fee that is charged alongside the Working Families Funding. When accessing the Working Families, your child is eligible for up to 30 hours per week, over 38 weeks per year (up to 1140 hours per academic year) of funded Early Education.

We offer all funded hours during term times, except where parents use less than 30 hours per week and choose to stretch their funding to allow their child to attend all year round. Sessions taken over and above the funded hours and during school holidays are charged at our usual daily rates.

Prior to new Government guidance that came into effect from April 2025, it was our standard policy to explain our Additional Services Fee during registration and then include this voluntary charge for all children accessing Working Families Funding on an hourly basis, asking parents to opt out if they were unable or unwilling to pay this fee.

The Government have decided that from 1st April 2025, these costs need to be broken down to add transparency to the fees we are charging and allow you to understand where they come from. If you are unable or unwilling to pay the additional services fee, we ask that you inform us of your choice before taking up your child's place so we can provide you with a copy of our 'Provision of Own Supplies Policy' in which it will detail everything you will need to provide yourself, including the strict guidelines that will have to be followed if you choose not to take our meals and snacks.

In line with Government Legislation, the funding is intended to cover delivery of the Early Years Foundation Stage, it is not intended to pay for the things that as a full day care setting, we provide, including but not limited to the items and services listed in the table below.
